


GENDER-RESPONSIVE LOCAL ECONOMIC ASSESSMENT TOOL

Inclusive and Equitable Local Development Programme: A Joint UNCDF, UNDP and UN Women Initiative

A gender-responsive LEA is a written report containing qualitative and quantitative data and analysis on a local economy. It contains text and schematics to present the main characteristics of a local economy viewed and analysed from a gender perspective. Data is drawn from existing reports, national policy documents and local data, where such data is available. A comprehensive gender-responsive LEA will be supplemented by stakeholder analysis using workshops and interviews with key individuals with knowledge and experience of the main gender issues impacting the local economy. Such analysis will draw on the insights of key stakeholders (women and men, jointly and/or separately, as culturally adequate) and groups with knowledge of gender issues and the impact of gender in the local economy. Such issues will for example, include the economic sectors women and men are concentrated in, or the social norms that hinder women's economic participation.
